The WVTA holds an annual CONTEST for Continuing Education. The State may require 15 credits in a two-year period but we know many of you go above and beyond that! We would like to reward you for your efforts! In addition, you are helping us to gather information about topics, speakers, and modalities. Please keep in mind that this contest is in no way related to the official record keeping of the Department of Regulation and Licensing. This is a CONTEST and your submission is purely of your own choice. It does not affect your license.

First, Second and Third place winners receive a special prize. Last year, we gave certificates for WVTA CE programs, NAVTA memberships, and WVTA memberships! Even if you don't think you are in the running for a top prize, we still encourage you to apply. A consolation prize is awarded to **every** person who submits a Score Sheet!!! Prizes are awarded at the Fall Convention. If you are unable to attend, please indicate on the Score Sheet and your prize will be mailed to you. We appreciate your taking the time to fill out the form and best of luck!

SCORING: This CONTEST applies to CE completed between Aug. 31st, 2006 and Sept. 1st, 2007.

- Fifty minutes of contact time is equal to one CE credit. Please do not use fractions less than 1/2 (0.5).
- All in-person CE events sponsored by approved providers i.e. WVTA, AVMA, UW-Vet School, etc. are acceptable.
- For purposes of this CONTEST, you may also include CE programs sponsored by food and drug representatives.
- For purposes of this CONTEST, you may count all of your web-based CE toward your total. Web-based CE is scored according to the number of CE credits assigned by the provider i.e. VSPN or Vet Med Team.
- For purposes of this CONTEST, you may count all CE earned by completing the *Veterinary Technician Magazine* CE quizzes.
- For purposes of this CONTEST, you may include Home Study programs such as the Hill's Health Care Connection per the amount of CE assigned by the provider.
- Because this is a CONTEST, you CANNOT include the hours spent reading scientific journals. We simply don't have a way to verify. Sorry. Happy reading though!
- For purposes of this CONTEST only, you can count any WVTA meetings attended as CE. You are after all contributing to professional development by attending! Go ahead and award yourself one CE credit for each hour spent with us! ☺
