

# WVTA Continuing Education Contest Guidelines

Continuing Education: Educational programs that enhance your ability to perform your work as a Veterinary Technician.

Scoring:

- 1 point 1 hour in-clinic seminar or 1 hour of on-line chat (VSPN, etc.)
- 2 points Hill's, Purina, Iams, or Drug company seminar. (2 hours)
- 3 points District Meeting, WVMA district meeting
- 4 points 1/2 day Meeting (4 total hours)
- 8 points 1 day Meeting, Expo (1 day), UW-Madison Seminar, Spring Wet Lab, Fall Convention (1 day), Winter Retreat (1 day), Other State Conventions. (8 total hours)
- 10 points Home study programs: Hill's Health Care Connection, Entire Year of Veterinary Technician Magazine Continuing Education, AVDT home study course. (These courses must be completed at the time of sending in this form)
- 16 points 2 day Meetings, Expo (2 days), Fall Convention (2 days), Winter Retreat (2 days), Other State Conventions. (16 total hours)
- 18 points Classes that directly pertain to the Veterinary Technician Field. (More than 16 hours)
- 25 points Meetings more than two days, North American Veterinary Conference, Western States Convention, National Meetings. (Meetings that total 40 hours plus)
